LOVE

If you have an Advent wreath, go ahead and light all four of the candles, remembering hope, peace, joy, and now, love. If you don't have an Advent wreath, find any candle and light it before reading this devotion.

This final week of Advent urges us to remember love.

1 John 4:19 says, "We love because he first loved us."

We love.

As God's kids, that's simply who we are. We are called to love.

Love can look like a whole lot of things - showing up, listening, making a meal, lending a truck, spending unhurried time with people, the list goes on.

But we are only able to do this because we *are loved*. You are deeply loved by the God who knows every inch of your heart.
