READ: John 1:9-14

ASK: What does it mean that Jesus "gives light" to everyone? ACTIVITY: Build a fort, get a flashlight, and read a Christmas book inside!

READ: Galatians 4:4-5 ASK: What does it mean that you are adopted by God? ACTIVITY: Call a grandparent and ask them about favorite Christmas traditions from their childhood.

READ: Isaiah 9:6 ASK: What are some other names for God? What does your name mean? ACTIVITY: Name all of Santa's reindeer as fast as you can!

READ: Matthew 2:9-11

ASK: What gift would you bring to baby Jesus? ACTIVITY: Quick! In less than five minutes, find something in your house you would give to baby Jesus. Then tell us why you chose it!

READ: Matthew 2:1-2 ASK: How do you worship Jesus? ACTIVITY: Drive around tonight and look at Christmas lights. See if you can find a star like the wise men's!

READ: Luke 2:8-12

ASK: What's something that brings you great joy? ACTIVITY: How do you think the sheep reacted to a whole host of angels interrupting their sleep?? Act it out!

READ: Luke 2:4-7

ASK: Why do you think Jesus was born in a place like a manger instead of a palace? ACTIVITY: Make a "pillow bed" on the floor and watch a Christmas movie!

READ: Luke 2:13-15 ASK: Do you think you would have reacted like the shepherds? Why or why not?

ACTIVITY: Facetime a friend/family member and surprise them with some virtual caroling

READ: Luke 2:17-18

ASK: What's the last thing you wanted to "spread the word" about? ACTIVITY: Take a selfie with your Christmas tree and spread some joy!

READ: Luke 2:16-19 ASK: What is your earliest Christmas memory? ACTIVITY: Have a living room dance party to your favorite Christmas songs!

READ: Matthew 1:18-21 ASK: Do you remember your dreams? What is the craziest dream you remember? ACTIVITY: Make a festive Christmas greeting video and post it to The Point Knox Church Facebook Group.

READ: Isaiah 7:14

ASK: What does Immanuel mean? Why do you think Jesus was called that? ACTIVITY: Think of some ways you can "be Jesus" to someone today. (Doing someone else's chore? Giving change to a Salvation Army Santa? Bringing cookies to a neighbor?)

READ: Matthew 2:3-6

ASK: What is a prophesy? Why are they important in the Bible? ACTIVITY: Make and decorate paper crowns while reading the rest of the wise men's story.

READ: Romans 15:13

ASK: Do you feel like you "overflow" with hope? Pray through that verse! ACTIVITY: Activity: Buy "reindeer droppings" for tomorrow's breakfast (donut holes!)

READ: James 1:17

ASK: What are three things you're thankful for today? ACTIVITY: Write a letter to Jesus, thanking him for the gifts you received throughout the year.

READ: Proverbs 17:22 ASK: How will you seek joy today? ACTIVITY: Drink some hot chocolate (Grown-ups, or treat yourself to a fun, festive cocktail!)

READ: John 1:4-5 ASK: How can you shine like Jesus today? ACTIVITY: Brainstorm a "Random Act of Kindness" you can do today!

READ: Luke 1:26-33 ASK: How do you think Mary felt after that angel's visit? How would *you* have felt?

DO: Play a board game under the Christmas tree!

READ: Micah 5:2

ASK: Why do you think God chose a village like Bethlehem to be the birthplace of Jesus? ACTIVITY: Pick 3 countries. Then go to <u>whychristmas.com/cultures</u> and learn about how they celebrate Christmas there!

READ: Luke 1:39-45

ASK: Who are your "Elizabeths"? Who are the people who will help you, celebrate with you, and speak truth into your life? ACTIVITY: Write a handwritten Christmas card to one of those people!

READ: Titus 3:4-7 ASK: Why does it say God saved us? Why is that important? ACTIVITY: Recreate a festive photo from holidays past.
